

This is a book you don't want to put down once you start reading. It is divided into individual crashes, interesting facts about passengers on board and how each crash happens. The only thing I didn't really care for was the technical information on each crash and exactly how it happened. A pilot would love this part but it's really not that interesting to those of us who don't fly planes. I would recommend this book to any adult.

As always, this author's books are supremely researched and presented. A lot of the technical jargon is daunting at times, but the glossary at the back of the book is very helpful. I am so sad that he has passed on - RIP.

Really well done series on aviation safety though well written "story" of the accident event (vs. NTSB just-the-facts report). Series quality consistent across volumes and span the prop age thru jets. Technical, but clear.

As a former pilot I loved this book. The authors expertise is amazing. He breaks down the technical into something that can be easily understood by the average reader. My only quibble is a lot of information about the passengers in order to put a human face on tragedy, but this is a small thing and can be skipped over. Having read many accident investigation reports his analysis are clear and concise. This whole series is a great read and brings up significant issues not just for the airline industry, but the whole problem of machine and man interface

To my eye, having read Job's previous books, he seemed to relate the sequence of how the accidents occurred, followed by a near identical rehashing of earlier information !Sorry about his demise; he has provided many hours of of entertaining and imformative reading.
