

This book was not updated significantly from the original first edition. It also suggested the use of things like stepwise regression, which is widely known in the current research to not be a sufficient analyses. It also came to conclusions that I feel assessment experts today would simply disagree with. There were several occasions where the authors said things and then later contradicted themselves later. Overall, I would not recommend this book under any circumstances to guide assessment practitioners in the field. I gave it two stars because it wasn't completely wrong and because Astin has some other really great work. This book however, was disappointing to say the least.

Understanding that this is an "updated" version of an old classic which was out of print, I was disappointed that not much of the current scholarship was used for the update. In the last chapter, AAHE was cited as doing outstanding work in the assessment field and AAHE has been defunct for about 10 years. I would not recommend this as a work that adds anything to the current literature and findings on assessment and evaluaion.
