I'd first like to start by saying that it's ridiculous that this thing costs \$45 dollars; the government needs to set a price ceiling on this ASAP. This PoS technology is worth no more than \$10, cause it's literally not that much different from a tv remote. In addition to the ridiculous price tag due to the

monopoly, it's quality is terrible. The plastic game is too strong, and you can hear things shaking inside if you shake it, which shows how little effort went into crafting this. Maybe I got a lemon, but it turns on when it feels like it, not when I need it. I would sit there pressing the on button 20 times before it finally turned on. And once it is on, if you move it too fast, it will turn off. You can't even set it down on a table normally, you have to be really slow and careful so it doesn't turn off. I urge someone to make an app that does the same thing instead, because the iClicker is the scum of the earth. But you'll probably end up buying this anyway cause you're professor required it. I'm sure this item is useful to someone, but it is not needed if you have a smartphone. Simply download the Reef application and purchase a short subscription for 6 or 12 months. The cost is around \$15-20 for that subscription and allows you to do the same things. I had to purchase this for a Chemistry class and found out after the purchase that the professor was fine with either the clicker or the application as they did the same things. I'm also not a fan of the return policies on here as I returned the item in identical condition (never even opened the package) but only got 50% of my purchase cost back with no indication as to why. I have also discovered there appears to be no way to contest this value anywhere on . Hopefully this post can help prevent someone else from wasting money on this product when it is not needed.

Got the clicker for my college course. It was shipped rather quickly and came with the 6 months of reef polling (the app version for your phone) and two batteries. My main concern was buying it, and it not working. This was the opposite and 2 months later, it still works well and is in good condition. My batteries are dying out, but you can't complain especially since I received them for free!

Works just fine. Unfortunately could not use the app in my classroom because of poor wifi conditions (come on UCLA it's 2015). Would recommend getting the older model for cheaper, unless you really need that screen.

It works but I made a mistake I was trying to purchase the Iclicker 2 this is basically a regular Iclicker with some added feature that I didn't use and don't even remember if I got it working, in sum get the original Iclicker and save yourself some money

Great, new batteries and everything ready to go for my first day of college!

First I must warn that this is an iClicker+ which is still basically an iClicker 1, not the iClicker 2 which some professors may require. With that being said, the remote works quite well, it's better than the original iClicker 1 in that it has LED lights to provide feedback and confirm to the user that their answer has been submitted. It does not have a screen like the iClicker 2, nor does it support numeral answers like the iClicker 2. Be sure to check with your professor to see if they allow the original iClicker or the iClicker 2, but as long as they allow the original, this device works quite well compared to the competition.

No however maybe not your fault! My son had to get the university sold clicker. I would of thought this clicker could have been programmed by any university! I spent almost 40 dollars on this and it's useless
