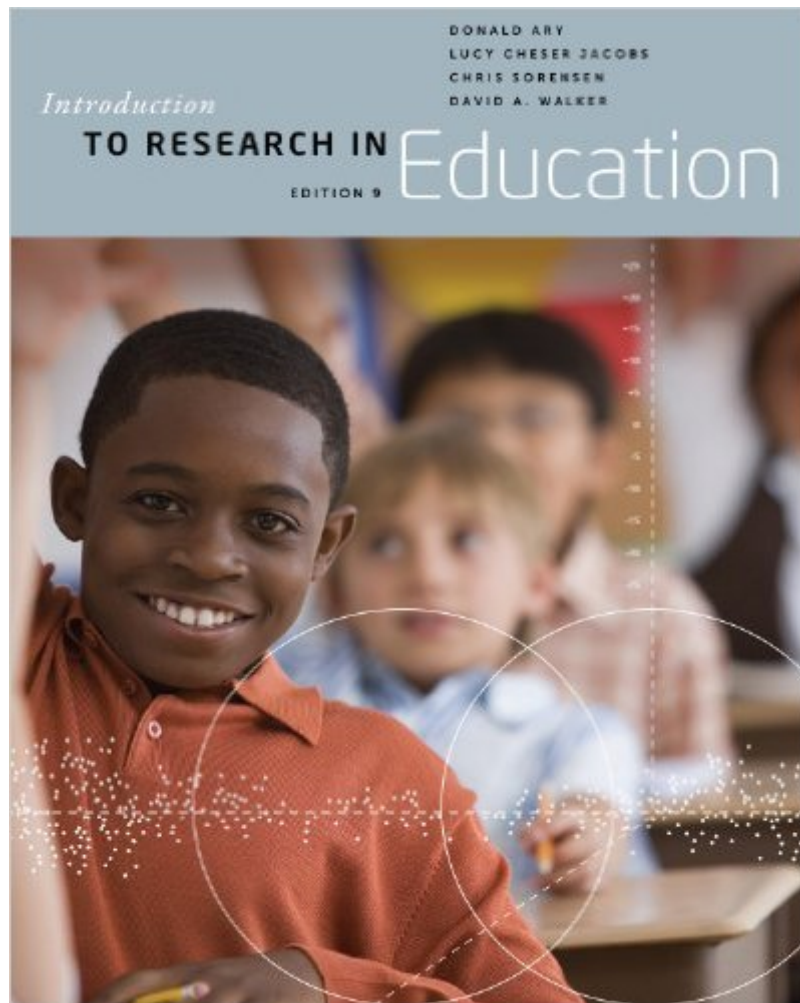

But if you have a choice about what text to get, RUN AWAY. I'm glad I've rented this book for my class vs purchasing. I will not be sorry to see it disappear off my iPad's Kindle app when the semester is over. It's a dry subject, made drier and more complicated than necessary. The text does fine explaining concepts, but the math explanations are terrible. It's not that I don't understand

math--I actually am quite good at it. Unfortunately, the text is laid out in such a way as to make it more difficult. Paragraphs upon paragraphs of explanation, followed by an equation. No sidebars to highlight key ideas or anything like that, so if you've missed any small bits of info about this equation you have to reread pages in order to find what you're missing. So frustrating. There are also far too many errors--my professor has a handout of the errata that he has found, including errors in the answers to exercises at the end of the chapters. Ridiculous! I was racking my brain to figure out a math error until I found it among the mistakes my prof had found. I had it right to begin with!

This book is not the most interesting read but it's easy to understand. I do not enjoy the technicalities of research in general, so perhaps my opinion is a bit biased. However, this text does provide a good overview of the different types of research methods and how to start.
