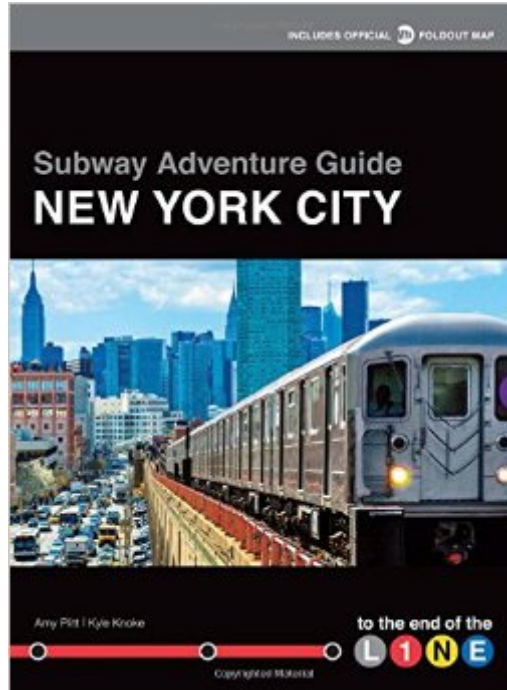

It takes a lot of the guess work out of the subway and makes it really easy to plan your destinations based on the line. The destinations are definitely more authentic than the tourist traps lots of guide books send you to. For decades, I'd pondered the subway schematic map and tried to figure out a way to master it.
