I ran a nonprofit foundation program that hired graphic recorders--Heather and Nora were among that group--to work with middle school students and teachers in both single day sessions and weeks long camps. *Draw Your Big Idea* is the book that we have needed to make better practitioners of everyone involved. There are many excellent and useful books about graphic recording, but this one provides a drawing toolkit that will break down the inhibitions of the people who insist that they "can't draw."

As a non-drawer, I was skeptical at first. But these authors have figured it out! Draw Your Best Idea is a perfect guide to visual expression of ideas in order to move something from vision to execution. Two huge Likeable thumbs up!

Draw your Big Idea is actually two books in one. The first part offers a fun way to get to know yourself and understand your goals, strengths and motivation - all those things you can actively work with. The graphic approach, combined with powerful questions lets you run a great self-guided coaching session. I liked the second part of the book even better - being an entrepreneur myself, I know that it sometimes gets hard to clearly define what it is you want to offer to whom. The short exercises in the book were fun and created a lot of new insight. To me, the biggest value of this book is in the structure it provides - the great graphics, examples and short assignments make it fun to learn more about yourself and kick-start your Big Idea... oh, and I decided that I need to draw more :-)

I met Nora and Heather several years ago at a conference for graphic recorders and was **WOWED** by the power of their 'visual presence.' Both are extraordinarily talented women and have much to offer. I was thrilled to see that they were publishing a book and pre-ordered it immediately. When the book arrived, I couldn't wait to dive in. The book is **BEAUTIFUL**, well organized and will be a great tool for a variety of audiences! Grab your markers and get to work! The lay out, content and exercises support deep reflection and great insight.
